



Assistance is now available for individuals and families who are having difficulty maintaining their current rental housing or have lost their housing. Eligibility to participate in this program is subject to criteria established by the US Department of Housing and Urban Development, the State Department of Housing and Community Development and the Kings County HPRP Collaborative. The ultimate goal of this program is to assist households in maintaining stable, long-term housing.

Please note that the following information is only basic criteria for participation and that other criteria will apply. This is not a mortgage assistance program. A referral for services is required. This funding is limited and the service will be discontinued when the funding is depleted.

What is HPRP?

- A new program being offered to persons who have lost their housing or are having difficulty maintaining their housing **AND** meet all eligibility criteria.
- A new program to provide temporary financial and housing stabilization assistance to help persons maintain stable, permanent housing.

What are some of the program requirements?

- Applicants must live in Kings County and meet income requirements.
- Applicants must meet target population criteria and secure a referral from an organization serving the target population.
- Applicants must agree to meet regularly with a case manager.
- Applicants must demonstrate an ability to sustain stable, permanent housing.

This program provides subsidies only, is short term, and is not intended to be the sole source of financial assistance for rental payments. **For more information, please call The Salvation Army at (559) 582-4434.**
